SECTION 5

SCHOOL JUDGED INADEQUATE [4] ON SIAS INSPECTION

STEP 1

SCHOOL JUDGED INADEQUATE ON S5 INSPECTION OR PUT INTO SPECIAL MEASURES

REPORT TO DBE AND NS, SCHOOL, PARENTS ETC WITHIN 8 WEEKS OF INSPECTION

STEP 2

REPORT TO DBE AND OFSTED, SCHOOL, PARENTS ETC

VISIT BY DDE TO SCHOOL TO OFFER PASTORAL SUPPORT, OUTLINE PLAN OF ACTION TO BE COMPLETED WITH GB ASAP AFTER REPORT IS OUT IN PUBLIC DOMAIN

STEP 3

LA & DDE ENSURE EFFECTIVE HT AND SMT IN PLACE, WORKING WITH EFFECTIVE GB, OFFERING ADVICE AND SUPPORT, AND ALSO DBE OFFICER VISITING THE SCHOOL

TIMESCALE AGREED FOR ACTION PLAN TO BE PUT INTO ACTION AND MONITORED AND SUPPORTED BY DBE WITH ANNUAL VISIT

STEP 4

CLEAR APPROACH TO INTERVENTION POLICY APPOINTING ADDITIONAL GOVERNORS IF NECESSARY

**SUCCESS CRITERIA**  
IN ONE YEAR - TOOLKIT AND DAY VISIT BY INSPECTOR [ THE SAME ONE] AND TO SEE IT THE SCHOOL HAS MOVED TO AT LEAST GRADE 3 [SATISFACTORY]

STEP 5

**Success Criteria for:**  
i) schools in special measures and ii)] Notice to Improve  
NB For fuller details pertaining to each LA procedure, please see the respective documents provided by each Local LA

FURTHER STEPS

If school identified by OFSTED as requiring special measures

Schools receive short- notice monitoring visits led by HMI; and if still in special measures, will be re- inspected by OFSTED after two years. HMI may decide to remove school from special measures or move it to category 'Notice to Improve'

If school identified by OFSTED as requiring significant improvement (Notice to Improve)

Schools receive a 'Notice to Improve' and will be inspected between 12-16 months after OFSTED inspection  
Some schools judged satisfactory by OFSTED may receive an interim monitoring visit by OFSTED within twelve months
