

Easter Labyrinth

Want to bring the Easter Story to life for pupils in your local school?

An event for Clergy, lay leaders, children's workers and anyone else interested!

Sharing the Easter Story with KS2 children using your church building.

St Laurence's Church, Bell Green, Coventry has found a very successful way to do this which is well-received by teachers and also a lot of fun.

For the last 10 years, at St Laurence's, we have used our church building to create an Easter Labyrinth for local school children in Years 4, 5 or 6. This complements the Easter Module in the National Curriculum. We know that our 5 local schools all teach this module to different year groups, so they are all keen to bring groups to the Easter Labyrinth.

We re-create the scenes from the Easter story - including a (reasonably) life size Easter tomb! We use activities, images, craft and worksheets to give the children an insight into the Easter Story which is central to our Christian Faith. We also include something about Easter customs and food from round the world and aim to make the experience both thought-provoking and enjoyable.

It is very do-able and a way of engaging imaginatively with the next generation.

We suggested that other churches could also do this. So, during this 2010 Easter season, there is an opportunity for you to come along and experience it for yourself. Then you can see how you could do this in your own church and offer it to your local schools next year?
